2018 - 2019 SACRAMENTAL PROGRAMME

Thank you for your interest in our Parish's Sacramental Programme in which, we help you to prepare your child for the reception of Reconciliation, Confirmation, and First Communion. The Sacraments are received in this order in Auckland Diocese and most of the Dioceses in New Zealand; this may be different to what you are used to if you come from other countries.

The programme provides some of the final formation for the reception of these Sacraments; it implies that the child is already prepared in other ways, such as having a basic knowledge of the Catholic faith, daily prayer and weekly Mass. They must either be attending a Catholic School or have attended at least one year of the Education in Faith (EIF) classes for students attending a non-Catholic School. It is not possible to provide sufficient education and formation in nine short lessons.

At this stage most of the sessions will be held during the 5:30pm Sunday evening mass where the children will be dismissed during the mass, similarly to the way they are dismissed at the 9:30am mass to attend children's liturgy.

On the Enrolment Form attached we request the following:

- confirm you have read this Information and Dates Sheet
- commit to attend all of the parent sessions
- commit to all the Sunday sessions for the children
- complete the series of weekly worksheets at home

It is important that your child is involved in all of the sessions to be fully prepared for receiving these Sacraments and therefore ask you to avoid committing your child to any other activity which would clash with the Programme times. You must understand that there will be no "catch up" sessions run for sessions missed for any reason. In the past, parents have made unreasonable demands on Leaders.
