Things to Take.....

DON'T FORGET ANYTHING USE THE CHECKLIST

PLEASE NAME EVERYTHING!!!!

BEDDING

- Sheet (to cover the mattress) – single fitted sheet fits best.
- Pillowcase (pillows are supplied by the Camp)
- Sleeping bag or blanket

TOILETRIES

- Toilet gear/toothbrush/toothpaste/soap/shampoo/conditioner/hair brush/comb/flannel/sunscreen/lip balm and insect repellent (roll on or cream recommended, no sprays please)
- Towel x 2 for showering
- Swimsuit and towel for water activities

CLOTHING

- 4 x T shirts/tops (T shirts to have short sleeves/no singlet or shoestring tops)
- 6 pairs of socks
- 3 x shorts
- 2 x track pants/long pants for evening
- Underwear for 5 days
- 2 x warm jumpers/sweatshirts
- Pyjamas (summer)
- Sneakers/trainers suitable for walking and morning run
- Sandals/jandals for around camp area
- Waterproof jacket
- Aqua shoes – (water activities)
- Sunhat

INCLUDE ALSO

- Plastic bags for dirty and wet clothing, shoes etc
- Camp booklet, pen, pencil,
- Reading book and playing cards
- Small torch plus working batteries
- Tissues
- Camera - optional

CAMP DAYPACK – children are required to take their daypack on Monday in the bus and we will require it for tramping to Mansion House.

- Lunch for the first day – (please do not use a lunchbox, use a throw away wrapping)
- Water bottle to be used throughout the week (named and refillable)

MEDICATION - All medication is to be in a ziplock bag with your child's full name and the dosage instructions. All medication is to be handed in to Sue Kubala for both camps (on the morning before departure)

HOME BAKING

We would like each family to provide some homemade biscuits, cakes or slices for the morning and afternoon teas. Please use a disposable container e.g. ice cream container. Food to be packed in child's luggage and we will collect it at Camp Bentzon.

- Rooms 18, 19, 21, 22 - **home baking**
- Rooms 20 and 23 - **2 packets of chocolate mini bars**

EXTRAS

NO other food is necessary. The children will be very well fed.

NO lollies, chocolates, chips, fizzy drinks etc ... Treats will be available for the children and the adults.

NO money, cell phones, electronic devices (ipads, tablets)

Please, please ensure every item of clothing and towels are **named clearly**. If items are misplaced, it is so much easier to return them to their owners if they are named. Laundry pens make clothes marking quick and easy. Vivids are ideal for plastic ware and other hard surfaces.

Please pack **securely** and **compactly** in one piece of luggage.

If the sleeping bag cannot be placed inside the bag, it should be in a waterproof bag that is securely tied and named.

The children will be responsible for carrying their own luggage.
