DESCRIPTION OF CLASSES

Musical Theatre Class

Monday \$110 includes materials 3:45-4:30pm Year 3-6

TUTOR: Tracey Hanne

Musical Theatre Class develops skills in singing, acting and movement through a variety of performance styles. This class builds a foundation for musical theatre song performance by:

- teaching students to use their own personal voice type to sing a range of songs
- analysing lyrics to find out how to communicate the story
- training vocal and physical expression
- developing characters so as to bring songs to life on stage both musically and dramatically.

In a fun and supportive environment, we will explore solo, duet and group dynamics, voice projection, movement while singing and speaking, and acting through drama based games and activities.

Drawing Class
