Concept learning

This year our overarching concept is <u>Taonga</u> (<u>Gifts</u>) and we want the students to "Live like Jesus to protect and nurture taonga in our common home.

Our term three concept is <u>Innovation</u> with the understanding that Innovation results from creative problem solving to protect and nurture the taonga of our common home.
