DESCRIPTION OF CLASSES

Dance/ Drama Class

Friday \$70 for 9 weeks 2:45-3:45

Tutor: Louise Parker

Welcome! In this class I aim to teach your children about the wonderful world of dance and drama. We will learn and create our own unique works of art over the term and become more confident in creating and performing. Art is all around us and I look forward to helping your children explore their creative side.

Senior Public Speaking Class

Monday \$84 for 8 weeks 2:45 – 3:30pm Year 5-6 ONLY

In this class, I aim to give students an opportunity to develop public speaking skills as well as grow in confidence. There is only a small number of placements in order for students to gain maximum personal attention. There will also be some homework (research and practice for speeches and debate) that will be expected of each student. Topics to be covered include: body language, speech structure, impromptu, researching your topic and more. This is a great opportunity to encourage your child in their public presentation leading into intermediate.

JUNIOR Public Speaking Class

Year 2-4 (must be able to read and write sentences)

This is a great class for children to learn confidence when speaking in a crowd. While some public speaking skills will be taught, the main aim is to build confidence, encourage creativity in writing and reading. Classes are kept smaller so that each student has more attention.
